86.101	Acute hospitals	Acute hospitals	Excludes: Adult mental health departments in acute hospitals categorised under '86.104 Mental health hospitals for adults'. Children and adolescent mental health departments categorised under '86.105 Mental health hospitals for children and adolescents'.
86.102	Specialised hospitals	Acute hospitals	Includes: Treatment of patients with particular somatic diseases such as cancer, pulmonary diseases, rheumatism, etc.
86.103	Other specialised health institutions	Acute hospitals	Includes: Specialised health institutions not listed elsewhere, including maternity and hospital services.
86.104	Mental health hospitals for adults	Other specialist health service	Includes: All 24-hour care institutions/departments for adult mental health treatment (mainly patients over 18 years old). Excludes: Institutions that only provide day treatment categorised under '86.223 Outpatient mental health clinics for adults'.
86.105	Mental health hospitals for children and adolescents	Other specialist health service	Includes: All 24-hour care institutions/departments for children and adolescent mental health treatment (mainly patients 0-17 years old). Excludes: Institutions that only provide day treatment categorised under '86.224 Outpatient mental health clinics for children and adolescents'.
86.106	Drug treatment units within specialist health services	Other specialist health service	Includes: All 24-hour care institutions/departments that provide cross-disciplinary, specialised substance abuse treatment. Excludes: Institutions that only provide day treatment categorised under '86.225 Outpatient clinics for substance abuse'.

86.107	Rehabilitation institutions	Other specialist health service	Includes: Medical rehabilitation institutions that carry out treatment plans so that those who are disabled due to illness, injury or a genetic disorder can regain, maintain or develop their ability to function and thus achieve the highest possible level of independence and quality of life. Also includes: Rehabilitation institutions that provide function-oriented treatment for regaining functionality following an illness or surgery.
86.211	General practitioners	Primary health service (excludes nursing homes)	Includes: General medical practices including community general practitioners with a general medical practice, and doctors in municipal accident and emergency departments. Excludes: Doctors in strictly administrative positions in the municipality (top-level management of multiple units) categorised under '84.12 Regulation of the activities of providing health care, education, cultural services and other social services, excluding social security'.
86.212	Outpatient clinics	Other specialist health service	Also includes: Plastic surgery.

86.221	Specialist doctors (excludes psychiatrists)	Other specialist health service	Includes: Medical practices that provide specialist services outside of general medical practices. Excludes: Psychiatric medical services categorised under '86.222 Psychiatrists'.
86.222	Psychiatrists	Other specialist health service	Excludes: Psychiatrists in strictly administrative positions categorised under '84.12 Regulation of the activities of providing health care, education, cultural services and other social services, excluding social security'.
86.223	Outpatient mental health clinics for adults	Other specialist health service	Includes: Outpatient mental health clinics for adults (mainly patients over 18 years old).
86.224	Outpatient mental health clinics for children and adolescents	Other specialist health service	Includes: Outpatient mental health clinics for children and adolescents (mainly patients 0-17 years old).
86.225	Outpatient clinics for substance abuse	Other specialist health service	Includes: Institutions that primarily provide treatment at level 1 (outpatient services including day treatment): social medicine outpatient clinics, substance abuse outpatient clinics and institutions with responsibility for Medication-Assisted Rehabilitation (LAR).
86.230	Dental health services	Primary health service (excludes nursing homes)	Includes: Dental services that provide general or specialised treatment, e.g. dental treatment, endodontics and paediatric dentistry, oral pathology and orthodontics. Also includes: Dental work in operating theatres. Excludes: Production of dentures and dental prosthetics by dental technicians categorised under '32.50 Manufacture of medical and dental instruments and supplies', hospital services for hospitalised patients categorised under '86.10 Hospital activities', and dental hygienists categorised under '86.90 Other human health activities.'

86.901	Home nursing care	Home care services	Includes: Health and care services provided over an extended period (more than 2-3 months) to patients living in a private home, in their own home, sheltered accommodation or a residential care home/shared dwelling. This applies where home nursing care is organised as a separate activity. Excludes: If home nursing care is provided exclusively in the same residential care home/shared dwelling, this is categorised under '87.302 Residential care homes for the elderly and disabled with 24-hour staffing' and '87.303 Residential care homes for the elderly and disabled with daytime staffing', respectively. Services with a greater caregiving orientation for patients living in private homes are categorised under '88 Social work activities without accommodation'.

87.101	Residential specialised nursing homes	Nursing homes	Includes: Dwellings with 24-hour nursing and caregiving pursuant to the Norwegian Municipal Health Services Act. Services adapted to special caregiving needs or groups, such as younger people. Often fewer spaces than a nursing home, and often more regional in nature than a nursing home.

87.301	Residential care activities for the elderly	Other health services	Includes: 24-hour care institutions for the elderly and disabled pursuant to the Norwegian Social Services Act. Excludes: Combined residential care activities for the elderly and nursing homes categorised under '87.102 Acute hospitals'.
87.302	Residential care homes for the elderly and disabled with 24-hour staffing	Other health services	Includes: Dwellings and shared dwellings with 24-hour staffing
87.303	Residential care homes for the elderly and disabled with daytime staffing	Other health services	Includes: Dwellings and shared dwellings with daytime staffing
87.304	Dwellings for short-term stays for the disabled	Other health services	Includes: Accommodation for short-term stays for the disabled. This may be a one-time stay or stays at fixed or irregular intervals. Recipients usually live in their own homes.
87.305	Sheltered accommodation for children	Other health services	Includes: Accommodation for people under 18 years old whose care needs mean they cannot live at home.
88.101	Home help	Home care services	Includes: Assistance with personal grooming and self-care, e.g. help to go to bed and get up, personal hygiene, using the toilet, dressing and undressing, help to eat, necessary monitoring and similar basic needs, also cleaning, food preparation, laundry and shopping (part of practical assistance).
88.102	Day care activities for the elderly and disabled	Other health services	Includes: Personalised services for groups with, e.g., mental health disorders, impaired mobility, intellectual disability or dementia. An administrative decision normally needs to be granted for these services.
88.103	Centres for the elderly	Other health services	Includes: Simpler, more openly accessible services than day centres/activity centres. Primarily provides a place for the elderly to gather socially, sometimes with services such as pedicures, cafes, hairdressers, etc.
